



Zoom-In Display.




Zoom-Out Display.

The touch of a button lets you zoom-in or zoom-out for a detailed close-up or larger overview. At the most detailed level every street is shown. The widest zoom level gives you a look at the national interstate system.

The scan button can be used to view areas of the map outside your current driving area. Scanning is useful for trip planning. The map can be scanned at any zoom level and will return to your current driving area by touching a single button.




